What we will do

Clyde-Green Springs Schools follows the steps contained in Ohio's Third Grade Reading Guarantee. We assess the reading skills of every child in kindergarten through grade 3 at the beginning of the school year. If we find that your child is not reading at the level needed for his or her grade, we will create a reading improvement plan just for your child. The plan will include extra reading time each day led by a trained reading teacher.

Our goal is to make sure that by the end of third grade, your child has the reading skills needed to be successful in higher grades, where learning relies more heavily on the ability to read. With the extra attention we give our struggling readers, many catch up *before* third grade.
