Last week our students participated in our school wide PBIS assembly to celebrate

They also learned about Responsibility which will be our focus for the second nine weeks of the school year. We also recognized the 176 students who had perfect attendance for the first nine weeks by having no absences or tardies. We challenged many more students to join that group by stressing the importance of attending school each day and coming on time. Both groups of students earned a certificate and a set of wings that many are displaying proudly on their backpacks. Congratulations to all the students who worked very hard for those awards. We look forward to recognizing those who show outstanding Responsibility as well as perfect attendance at our next PBIS assembly. Next week we will be recognizing our Honor Roll students from the first nine weeks.

Following these procedures allows the line to flow nicely and students are able to be in their classrooms for the start of the school day.
